

Please find the attached photos of David Martz flying in San Diego. This behavior is not uncommon to other reckless flying that he has been suspended for, including a wire strike in Mexico (recent suspension), and landing on a public street in front of Tommy Lee's home in Los Angeles (he was charged with a local crime for last year). I think a full investigation is needed of his past behavior and public safety in San Diego.

Another example:

(AP) A pilot faced reckless flying and other charges for landing a helicopter on a public street to pick up Tommy Lee and take him to a concert, prosecutors said.

David Keith Martz, 49, landed the helicopter July 7 outside a home in the Hollywood Hills to give the 43-year-old rocker a 50-mile flight to a Nine Inch Nails concert in Irvine, said Frank Mateljan, a spokesman for the City Attorney's Office.

Martz was charged with one count each of reckless flying, landing an aircraft on a public road and landing an aircraft without a permit, Mateljan said. Martz was to be arraigned in Hollywood on Wednesday.

Each charge carries a maximum penalty of six months in jail and a \$1,000 fine.
