AFFIDAVIT

I, Linda E. Ransom declare as follows:

Though I did not personally know or was not personally acquainted with Jeff L. Goldblum, for several months and on various occasions I frequented Playhouse West Studios auditing Robert Carnegie's Tuesday and Thursday acting classes. My later visit on April 22, 1999, is when I learned of an up coming film festival at the school.

It was then, April 25, 1999, that I met Mr. Goldblum at Playhouse West (PHW) - Studio 2, after attending the Playhouse West's 3rd Annual film festival. Here, I approached him (Goldblum) stating I have a script for the 'Jeff Goldblum' character and I wanted to include him. He gave me his manager's number and I gave him a slip of paper with my number on it. When I asked him how I could get in touch with him directly he stated, "I have your number right here", placing the paper I gave him in his right front pants pocket. We took some pictures together, and I left.

I did some research and found out from individuals that a manager is someone in the industry who cares. I called the number Goldblum gave me and they later returned my call. They wanted me to fax more information to them. However, I told them I needed to do more research to include sitting down talking with Mr. Goldblum and them (his reps.) first. *[I have 1/2 recording of this conversation made in May 1999.]*

As I continued to audit Carnegie's classes, he advised me they had no place for writers at the school, though I should do some acting somewhere else/ anywhere and they would come out and watch me. It wasn't until August 1999 that I was recommended by Robert Carnegie to attend/ sign-up for a PHW class.

STUDYING WITH PLAYHOUSE WEST

After a few weeks, one of my instructors directed our class to "Help Mr. Goldblum out" by attending the band sessions he conducted in the Los Angeles area - then at the Argyle Hotel. It was there I told Goldblum that I had joined the PHW -acting school and that I was still writing. He said it was a good school for 'serious Actors'. I told him I was a 'serious Writer' developing my skills. I took some pictures for him then. I continued to attend the weekly band sessions, though few of my class members bothered to return.

Later, my same instructor advised that 'Jeff Goldblum' was going to start teaching the class. I felt uncomfortable with the idea of working with him (Goldblum) in this type of classroom at this time, so I waited and spoke to Goldblum directly

after my class. I there informed him of my discomfort of him teaching my class (offering to change classes), because I was still studying his acting. He agree that he should be told first, and again offered to give me his manager's number - which I reminded him I had. I advised him that I did however want to study his directing and he agreed to allow this. After that day, Goldblum began showing up early after my class session and we would sometimes talk briefly. On rare occasions I would meet Goldblum before his Friday class. There I did ask if I was bothering him by these meetings and he stated "I never bother him".

Later, I began observing a few of his students who also ventured to the club at night - following Goldblum's band venues.

When nearing approximately 1 month as a regular student at PHW, I attempted to attend other beginning classes as allowed and listed on my schedule. One Monday however, I was met with contention from a student and thus Robert Carnegie. (One same student I observed at Goldblum's band venues)

Subsequently, Robert Carnegie sent a letter to the student, my instructors, and me, banning me from continuing as a student at the school stating a conflict *[refer to conflict in letter & class schedule about beginning classes]*

I later met with Goldblum before his Friday class showing him the letter. I attached the picture we took on our first meeting. He wanted me to continue, inviting me to enter his class with him. I thought it "better not to at this time" So, I sought to stay away from PHW for the time being.

I continued weekly returning to the Argyle and observed Goldblum's band. Interestingly, on various occasions when I would go to an isolated room, the next week session all the doors were wide open exposing my previous location to the main room. Therefore I continued my work usually in Goldblum's presence at the Argyle developing my writing, acting, & directing skills through 2000. In addition to Goldblum, I met Lincoln Adler, also a band member, having dialog with him on regular occasions both verbally and nonverbally. We all celebrated the 2000 New Year there also together (several pictures taken).

Finally on my birthday in May of 2000 Mr. Goldblum played piano (without singing at my request). I then reached and held Goldblum's hand for a few seconds afterward.

Later, I heard the band left the Argyle venue because of various complications and they sought a new location. I eventually found the band at the new location, the Las Palmas Supper Club.

There I continued to observe Goldblum's band, speaking to various band members and the crowd both regulars and new people. I then noticed I was being observed by John M. Mastro.

On various occasions at Las Palmas, Mastro would approach me usually inappropriately and interrupted conversation I was having with others. At one point I grew tired of his rude behavior, so I purposely left the crowded area and entered a quiet room; Mastro quickly followed me in. I decided to speak my thoughts out loud in his presence. Then he (Mastro) utters, "You are not talking to me!" I then spoke to him agreeing "No, I am not, and I was not talking to him earlier. Why are you always bothering me?" He made some rude comment threatening me. I looked at him and told him he should not be bothering me, that he could get hurt. I then left the room.

Mastro's inappropriate actions continued as on two other occasions at Las Palmas he blocked me from reaching the bathroom. (I later found out that he thought I was going to approach Goldblum). My only actions there was observation of the events.

OTHER VENUES WITH GOLDBLUM

On one occasion while the band performed at the Las Palmas restaurant, Mr. Goldblum mentioned they would be performing at "The Tempest" At this time Mr. Goldblum, sitting at the piano which faced me, openly stated "And you all are invited".

I went to this venue late (experiencing car problems) and immediately went over to speak to Goldblum who was carrying several presents. He appeared frustrated with me but would not speak on it. He chose to 'snub' me the rest of the night. I returned to PHW the next day to show him I had a problem with my tire - which I believe he then and there briefly observed.

On another occasion I asked Goldblum if I could go to the Beverly Hills Cigar Club when they performed, and he referred me to the band manager - John Mastro. I spoke to John and he said I could attend. I made it to this location about 2 times when Goldblum was there and once when he was not. Here, I introduced myself to Mel Gibson after playing with Mr. Goldblum from the audience and speaking to the singer who sat at my table that night.

Mastro's later action to bar me from the Las Palmas Supper Club followed an occasion I was having non-verbal conversation with Lincoln while he played in the band. Mastro told the guard not to allow me to enter the restaurant though I had not approached Mr. Goldblum or others in any threatening manner. Moreover,

Mastro's action appear to be based on his own ideas or inappropriateness coming from within himself, or the actions of others at the club he did not want me to witness.

**FOLLOWING GOLDBLUM'S
DIRECTIONS TO SUPPORT HIM**

On one occasion I observed Goldblum having an apparent problem at the band session. I decided to follow-up and speak to him at the school. He then & there said not to talk to him there and rushed to his car. I followed him to an unknown location where we exited our cars. He motioned I enter a building opposite of where he parked. I frustrated with his actions, refused and left.

The next week at the restaurant, Mastro approached me about the incident stating that I went to Goldblum's house. I told him I did not want to do that again and that I don't ever remember where I was.

Weeks later, Goldblum again appeared to have a problem at the club. This time from the restaurant, making sure to distance anybody else that was driving near, I followed Goldblum for his safety. I saw Goldblum's car enter a garage and the door close. I promptly left.

**COUNTY RECORDS INFORMATION
OPEN TO THE PUBLIC**

On another occasion when trying to contact Goldblum, I used the County records information open to the Public to find an address. I then told Goldblum I looked his address up in the Public records and found it.

-As of 12/06 I checked with the County records and noticed a change in the Public access to property records making it more difficult to acquire without assistance.

(Attempting to regain standing after Carswell, probation & IRS experiences)

Reaching new balance in my life, I began working with a company as a Hospice Volunteer. I returned to perfecting my writing and encountered a person with a complaint about PHW.

I then returned to PHW to speak to Robert Carnegie now before his Monday class (the same class which caused the conflict between us earlier). He allowed me to return to audit classes. However, I decided to use the name "Brenda Lee" from my screenplay when signing in.

My current research of Mr. Goldblum's activities made me return to his location after meeting with Carnegie's class. When Goldblum then claimed I was

'trespassing', I subsequently returned to signing in at the school with my correct name, and on one other occasion as student.

Later, my returning to PHW schedule included: Monday's & Auditing of some Tuesday and Thursday classes with Carnegie; Meetings with Tony Savant regarding introducing new students; and observing Mark Pellegrino a new instructor in my original class time. I followed-up when I could with Goldblum through conversations at his intercom.

-----TO CONTACT MR. GOLDBLUM-----

On August 17, 2006 I made a phone call to the number Mr. Goldblum gave me when we first met. This time I spoke to a male who indicated they are still the management representatives for Mr. Goldblum. I informed him, I was given a number years ago by Mr. Goldblum and that the office referred me to this direct number when I advised them about writing a script.

I inquired if Mr. Goldblum would be available for an appearance at the Costume party I was attending (I previously sent Goldblum notice about it) He stated Mr. Goldblum is really busy, but perhaps next year. I further inquired what was the best way to reach Mr. Goldblum and he said "If you are truly a friend of his you contact him directly." Again I followed up with Mr. Goldblum about the results of my efforts to include him.

I continued to contact Mr. Goldblum in a civil, and honest, and many time humorous manner, to avoid any misunderstanding and reduce any tension that could have developed between us over the 6 to 7 years I have been exposed to, and away from his presence. On these various occasions, Mr. Goldblum choosing to respond back to my inquires seemed to resolve any of our differences. It appears however, with some steps left out of our conversation problems arise causing me to be falsely accused of wrong doing. On other occasions the Assistance he gets seems to help him understand my actions are warranted and he follows through with my request without delay.

I have tried to maintain all records of correspondence and inquires I have made with that which is him to be.

I do not wish to cause Mr. Goldblum stress by informing him about what is happening in my life. However, I still have the treatment document he left his 'Paw' mark as endorsement on in May of 2000.

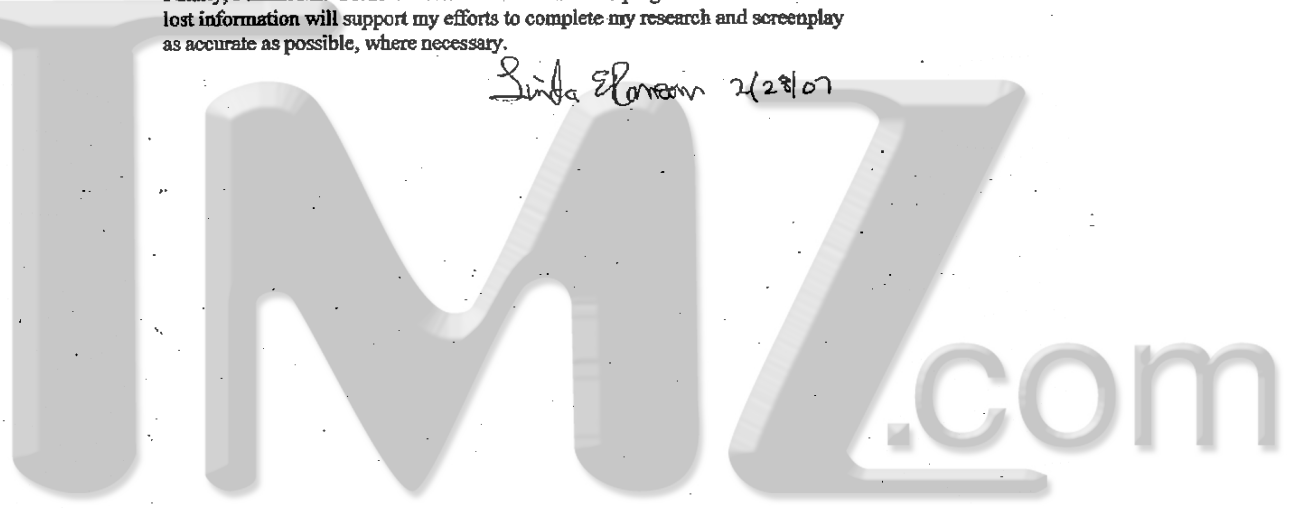
I did ask him first if I could include him in my story, though he had already helped me, the real hero, I meant it.

At this time, due to my prior memory problems, I needed Mr. Goldblum's help in retrieving some of our correspondence because I had no reference or other outside support. Therefore the escalation of repeat visits to his property was based on a sign of these times: *More people were becoming involved in the affairs including unknown visitors, in my home when I was not there present.* Also noting a time urgency, I needed positive results to the inquires I was making.

Moreover, regarding blocking his driveway, *which occurred mostly to deliver the Newspaper in the early mornings without delay,* happened so he would know and not be fearful or confused that some other unknown person was approaching his property.

Finally, I thank Mr. Goldblum and his Assistance. Helping me to recover some lost information will support my efforts to complete my research and screenplay as accurate as possible, where necessary.

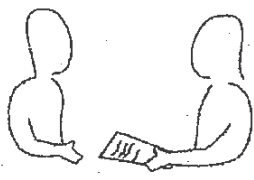

DECLARATION OF JESUS AVIT RODRIGUEZ

I, Jesus Avit Rodriguez, declare as follows:

1. I provided personal security services for Mr. J. Lynn Goldblum. I was employed by Gavin de Becker & Associates, located at 11684 Ventura Boulevard, Suite 440, Studio City, California from March 2006 through December 2006.

2. On October 4, 2006, at approximately 2:10 p.m., I was working a security detail at Mr. Goldblum's residence when I saw Ms. Ransom in front of his residence.

3. I approached Ms. Ransom and advised her that she was trespassing on private property. Ms. Ransom responded, "No I am not." She further represented that she was "a special agent who works for the government."

4. I advised Ms. Ransom that she was trespassing and that she would be arrested if she did not leave the premises. I also informed Ms. Ransom that the police had been notified and that they were on their way. Ms. Ransom refused to leave the premises, instead claiming that she was entitled to be there because she was a federal agent. She also reached into her purse.

5. Fearing for my safety, I restrained Ms. Ransom from the wrist while giving her numerous commands to drop her purse and belongings. She refused. I eventually was able to restrain her and sit her down on the front steps of Mr. Goldblum's residence to wait for the police to arrive.

6. At approximately 3:00 p.m., the Los Angeles Police Department came and took Ms. Ransom into custody.

I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the state of California that the foregoing is true and correct.

DECLARATION OF MATTHEW D. SLATOFF

I, Matthew D. Slatoff, declare as follows:

1. I provide personal threat management and security services for Mr. J. Lynn Goldblum. I am the Director of Investigations for Gavin de Becker & Associates, located at 11684 Ventura Boulevard, Suite 440, Studio City, California. In this position, I direct a staff of threat assessment practitioners, investigators, and mental health experts responsible for the assessment and management of situations that might pose a hazard to the safety or privacy of our clients.

2. In April of 2001, I became aware of a security threat posed by Ms. Linda Ransom when she first began to make unwanted and uninvited visits to Mr. Goldblum's home. It is my understanding based on talking with Mr. Goldblum in April of 2001 that Mr. Goldblum was distressed by Ms. Ransom's harassing and stalking behavior because Mr. Goldblum does not personally know Ms. Ransom and has no desire to have any contact with her and because Ms. Ransom found out where Mr. Goldblum lived by following him home late one night from Playhouse West, a school where he teaches classes. As a result of Ms. Ransom's threatening conduct, my staff and I began to monitor Mr. Goldblum's residence with 24-hour video surveillance.

3. Since April of 2001, Ms. Ransom's stalking and threatening conduct directed at Mr. Goldblum has escalated, especially during the past three months, to the extent that I believe Ms. Ransom poses an immediate threat to Mr. Goldblum's personal and bodily security, and unless a restraining order is secured, there will be no way to have the relevant law enforcement authorities act appropriately to prevent Ms. Ransom's continued stalking and frightening harassment of Mr. Goldblum.

4. My firm has documented through surveillance footage that Ms. Ransom has shown up at Mr. Goldblum's residence more than 50 times in the past three months. These

1 harassing, threatening, and uninvited visits have occurred even though Ms. Ransom has been
2 arrested for trespassing on Mr. Goldblum's property (on October 4, 2006) and for physically
3 attacking Mr. Goldblum's employee while trespassing on Mr. Goldblum's property (on June 30,
4 2001). On at least seven of these uninvited visits to Mr. Goldblum's residence during the past
5 several months, Ms. Ransom parked her car diagonally across Mr. Goldblum's driveway,
6 blocking his access to and from the property.

7 5. Ms. Ransom's more than 50 documented (by video surveillance) visits to Mr.
8 Goldblum's home in the past three months represent an escalating pattern of harassing,
9 threatening, and stalking conduct spanning nearly six years. Beginning on April 6, 2001, when
10 Ms. Ransom began to stalk and harass Mr. Goldblum, Ms. Ransom was warned repeatedly not to
11 return to Mr. Goldblum's residence by members of my security staff, Mr. Goldblum, Mr.
12 Goldblum's employee Mr. John Mastro, Los Angeles Police Department Officers, and Security
13 Patrol from Edison Security Patrol. Ms. Ransom has ignored these repeated requests and
14 warnings. I have also been advised by my security staff member, Mr. Jesus Avit Rodriguez, that
15 Ms. Ransom has also claimed that she was a federal officer and had every right to be on the
16 premises of Mr. Goldblum's residence.

17 6. In my experience as a threat assessment and personal security specialist, I have
18 found that when I and others, including members of law enforcement, speak to others who
19 present potential security threats and advise them to stop, they cease and desist in roughly 98%
20 of the cases. When they do not cease the harassing activity, they generally pose a serious threat
21 to the person they stalk and harass. Ms. Ransom is a textbook example of a person who poses an
22 extreme and serious threat to the target of her stalking and harassment, Mr. Goldblum.

23
24 **A. Ms. Ransom's Criminal History -- Prior Arrests for Stalking, Trespassing and**
25 **Battery & Federal Criminal Prosecution**

1 7. On June 30, 2001, Ms. Ransom showed up uninvited at Mr. Goldblum's residence
2 and physically attacked Mr. John Mastro, an employee of Mr. Goldblum, when Mr. Mastro
3 advised her to leave the premises. Ms. Ransom was arrested by the Los Angeles Police
4 Department for her stalking of Mr. Goldblum and physical attack on Mr. Mastro. Please see
5 LAPD Preliminary Investigation Report attached as Exhibit C. Although law enforcement
6 recommended the filing of charges against Ms. Ransom, the District Attorney made a
7 determination that there was insufficient evidence to proceed.

8 7. Based on public records, I learned that on June 28, 2001 Ms. Ransom was
9 charged with the federal offense of "Unlawful Acts Committed by Revenue Officer." Please see
10 Pacer print-out of the federal case against Ms. Ransom attached as Exhibit D. As a part of this
11 criminal proceeding, Ms. Ransom was ordered to undergo mental health treatment at Carswell
12 Federal Medical Center in Fort Worth, Texas, a federal detention/mental health facility. During
13 the time of Ms. Ransom's detention at Carswell from February 2002 to September 2002, Ms.
14 Ransom continued to send threatening, harassing, and disturbing correspondence to Mr.
15 Goldblum. These letters and packages evidence a delusional belief that she has a relationship
16 with Mr. Goldblum.

17 8. Based on public records, I learned that Ms. Ransom was deemed fit for trial in her
18 federal criminal proceeding and transferred back to Los Angeles in September 2002. See Exhibit
19 D. In October 2002, Ms. Ransom entered into a plea agreement whereby she was released to the
20 care of her mother. *Id.* In January of 2003, Ms. Ransom was sentenced to two years of
21 probation. *Id.*

22 9. Beginning in July of 2006, when Ms. Ransom's probation in the federal criminal
23 matter ended, Ms. Ransom again started to show up at Mr. Goldblum's home, uninvited, and
24 began to drop off materials addressed to Mr. Goldblum at his home. When Ms. Ransom again
25 resumed her stalking and harassing visits to Mr. Goldblum's residence, I became very concerned

1 about Mr. Goldblum's personal safety and I recommended that his security surveillance system
2 at his residence be upgraded and recommended 24-hour security detail. By October of 2006, an
3 upgraded security surveillance system was installed at Mr. Goldblum's residence.

4 10. Despite these efforts, Ms. Ransom continued to stalk, harass, and threaten Mr.
5 Goldblum, by showing up at his house unannounced and by showing up at the Playhouse West,
6 the school where Mr. Goldblum teaches. On October 4, 2006, Ms. Ransom was again arrested
7 for stalking Mr. Goldblum and trespassing on his property. Please see LAPD Arrest Report
8 attached as Exhibit B.

9 11. Since Ms. Ransom's October 4, 2006 arrest, the frequency of Ms. Ransom's
10 unwanted visits to Mr. Goldblum's home has escalated at an extremely frightening rate. In
11 October of 2006, Ms. Ransom unlawfully showed up at Mr. Goldblum's residence on seven
12 occasions. These threatening and harassing visits increased to nine in November of 2006, and
13 then increased to fifteen in December of 2006. In January of 2007, Ms. Ransom made twenty
14 uninvited, threatening, and harassing visits to Mr. Goldblum's residence. In at least five of these
15 visits (on January 11th, 14th, 18th, 21st, and 22nd), Ms. Ransom parked her car diagonally across
16 the driveway, blocking Mr. Goldblum's access to and from his home.

17 12. In addition, our surveillance cameras have documented that on January 14, 2007
18 Ms. Ransom brought a young unknown male with her to Mr. Goldblum's residence. This young
19 male rang the gate bell at Mr. Goldblum's residence multiple times. As a personal security and
20 threat specialist, I am particularly concerned that Ms. Ransom now is enlisting other persons
21 and/or agents in her stalking and harassing activities. I am concerned that Ms. Ransom is
22 circulating confidential information about Mr. Goldblum, including his home address which is
23 not publicly available, and enlisting the help of unknown persons to harass, threaten, and stalk
24 Mr. Goldblum.

1 **B. Ms. Ransom's Harassing & Threatening Correspondence**

2
3 13. During the past year, I have reviewed voluminous materials that Ms. Ransom has either
4 personally delivered to Mr. Goldblum's residence or mailed to his mailing address. These
5 materials, in my opinion and experience, clearly demonstrate Ms. Ransom's delusional belief
6 that she has a personal relationship with Mr. Goldblum and evidence the disturbing escalation in
7 Ms. Ransom's stalking and harassing activities directed against Mr. Goldblum. Please see letters
8 and materials, filed under seal as Composite Exhibit H.

9
10 **C. Conclusion**

11 14. Since April of 2001, I have had numerous discussions with Mr. Goldblum about the
12 threat that Ms. Ransom poses to his personal safety and well-being. It is my understanding based
13 on these conversations that Mr. Goldblum does not want, and has never wanted, any contact
14 whatsoever with Ms. Ransom. It is also my understanding that Mr. Goldblum has suffered, and
15 continues to suffer substantial emotional distress as a result of Ms. Ransom's escalating and
16 dangerous pattern of her stalking activities, which have interfered with and obstructed with Mr.
17 Goldblum's ability to conduct his daily affairs, in particular.


18 15. Ms. Ransom is a serious threat to Mr. Goldblum's personal and bodily security. This is
19 particularly so in light of the following facts: (a) Ms. Ransom's history of violence as
20 demonstrated by her physical attack on Mr. Goldblum's employee in an effort to get access to
21 Mr. Goldblum, (b) Ms. Ransom's criminal abuse of her former position as a federal officer to
22 possibly obtain confidential, private information about Mr. Goldblum, (c) Ms. Ransom's federal
23 criminal conviction and detention at a federal mental health treatment facility, (d) Ms. Ransom's
24 refusal to obey the warnings of the LAPD officers as well as those of Mr. Goldblum's employees
25 and security personnel, (e) Ms. Ransom's delusional belief that she has a relationship with Mr.

1 Goldblum, (f) Ms. Ransom's enlistment of others to visit Mr. Goldblum's house, and (g) the 30
2 visits that Ms. Ransom has made to Mr. Goldblum's residence in the past three months,
3 including seven visits where she has physically obstructed Mr. Goldblum's access to and from
4 his house.

5 16. It is my strongest belief that Ms. Ransom will persist in her dangerous and
6 threatening harassment and stalking of Mr. Goldblum unless and until ordered by this court to
7 stop.

8
9 I declare under penalty of perjury under the laws of the state of California that the
10 foregoing is true and correct.
