1 WHEREAS, on February 1, 2008 the Probate Department of the Los Angeles Superior
2 Court (the "Probate Court"), the Honorable Reva Goetz presiding, granted the application of
3 James P. Spears ("Mr. Spears"), as conservator of the person of Britney Jean Spears and as co-
4 conservator of the estate of Britney Jean Spears, for a civil harassment temporary restraining
5 order (the "TRO") against Osama ("Sam") Lutfi ("Mr. Lutfi"), setting the hearing on the
6 application for February 22, 2008;

7 WHEREAS, on February 14, 2008 the conservatorship proceedings in which the TRO
8 application was granted were removed to the United States District Court for the Central District
9 of California (the "Central District");

10 WHEREAS, on February 21, 2008 the Central District, the Honorable Philip S. Gutierrez
11 presiding, granted Mr. Spears' *ex parte* application to continue the TRO, setting a new hearing
12 on the TRO application for 1:30 p.m. on March 17, 2008;

13 WHEREAS, on February 26, 2008 the Central District, the Honorable Philip S. Gutierrez
14 presiding, remanded the case to the Probate Court;

15 WHEREAS, the Probate Court has set the hearing on the TRO application for 1:30 p.m.
16 on March 17, 2008; and

17 WHEREAS, Mr. Lutfi and Mr. Spears are in discussions that may resolve the issues
18 presented by the TRO application, thereby making a hearing unnecessary;

19 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED that:

21 1:30 p.m. on April 16, 2008, or such other date and time as may be convenient for
22 the Court; and

19 James P. Spears, as the Temporary Conservator of the Person and Temporary Co-
20 Conservator of the Estate of Britney Jean Spears respectfully submits his Ex Parte Application for
21 Order Authorizing Sale or Disposition or Consent to Sale or Disposition of Conservatee's Motor
22 Vehicles, as follows:

23 **Introduction**

24 On February 1, 2008, the Court appointed Mr. Spears Temporary Conservator of the
25 Person of Britney Jean Spears, and appointed Mr. Spears and Andrew M. Wallet Temporary Co-
26 Conservators of the Estate of Ms. Spears. Since that date, the temporary conservatorship has been
27 extended, and letters of temporary conservatorship of Ms. Spears' person and estate have been

1 extended to Messrs. Spears and Wallet consistent with the Court's orders. Mr. Spears has been the
2 duly appointed and acting temporary conservator of the person of Ms. Spears, and Mr. Spears and
3 Mr. Wallet have been the duly appointed and acting temporary co-conservators of the estate of
4 Ms. Spears.

5 Since February 1, 2008, numerous and significant issues have arisen, and the Temporary
6 Conservators have acted diligently to resolve such issues, including requesting various forms of
7 relief from the Court in furtherance of carrying out their duties, such as the authority to retain
8 attorneys and to take certain actions with respect to the Conservatee's assets. The issue that
9 currently requires immediate attention is selling or otherwise disposing of certain of Ms. Spears'
10 motor vehicles. Mr. Spears requests the authority for the Temporary Co-Conservators to sell or
11 dispose of or to consent to the sale or disposition of certain of Ms. Spears' vehicles, by the Co-
12 Trustees of the SJB Revocable Trust or the representative of any relevant entity.

13 **Statement of Facts**

14 Ms. Spears has seven motor vehicles. The cost of maintaining the vehicles includes
15 insurance costs, storage costs, and maintenance costs. It is in the interests of the conservatorship
16 estate for certain of the motor vehicles to be sold or disposed of, as doing so will save substantial
17 expense to the conservatorship estate.

18 Mr. Spears is informed and believes that Ms. Spears' vehicles are titled in the names of
19 various entities, including the names of trusts. Mr. Spears requests the authority for the
20 Temporary Co-Conservators of the Estate to sell or dispose of the vehicles that belong to the
21 conservatorship estate or to consent to the sale or disposition of the vehicles that are owned by the
22 trusts or one of the Conservatee's entities, through TBR Consultants/Spin Doctors, which shall sell
23 or otherwise dispose of the vehicles in the most efficient and cost-effective manner. TBR
24 Consultants/Spin Doctors shall receive a 5% commission for their services.

25 **Conclusion**

26 The Probate Code authorizes the Court to make orders in the best interests of the
27 Temporary Conservatee. Granting Mr. Spears' ex parte application would be in the best interests
28 of Ms. Spears. Based upon the foregoing, Mr. Spears respectfully requests an order authorizing


