Thank you for your participation as a prospective juror in this case. These questionnaires were designed to allow you to share necessary information in an efficient and private manner. Only the court and the individuals involved in the selection of a jury will view the information. The questionnaires will not be used for any other purpose, though they will become a part of the court's permanent record.

This written questionnaire is the first step in the jury selection process. Please answer all questions carefully and completely. Do not leave any blanks. If a question is not relevant to you, please write "NA" for "not applicable" in the provided space. During the second stage of jury selection, the judge and attorneys will have the opportunity to follow up on some of these questions in court. At that time, you will be given an opportunity to explain or expand any answers, if necessary. If there are any questions/answers you do not feel comfortable addressing in open court, please write the word "private" next to the question and you may be given the opportunity to answer in a private manner to only the judge, attorneys, and court reporter. *This is an extremely time-consuming approach and should be reserved only for those questions that will personally cause you extreme difficulty or embarrassment by answering them in open court.*

Although the press will be present during the questioning of jurors, all jurors' names are unavailable to all parties and the jurors will remain completely anonymous.

Please answer all questions by yourself, giving your very best effort to answer each question thoughtfully and honestly. There are no "wrong" answers. If you have any questions or need any assistance, please ask the court personnel. Do not discuss the questionnaire or your answers with anyone, including your family, friends or fellow jurors. When you have completed the questionnaire, please give it to the attendant. **PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE WITHOUT TURNING IN YOUR COMPLETED JUROR QUESTIONNAIRE.**

Write your juror number at the top of each page in the space provided. DO NOT write on the back of any page. If you need more room, use the bottom or side of the page or the page provided at the end of the questionnaire. Please write clearly so that your answers are easy to read.
