**FACTUAL CIRCUMSTANCES SURROUNDING ARREST OR INCIDENT:**

On 3/20/07 at approximately 10:57 p.m., CHP Officers in a marked patrol car were traveling e/b on US-101. As they continued east, a silver Cadillac SRX passed their patrol car at a high rate of speed. The front side windows of the Cadillac also had a dark window tint applied to them. The officers subsequently paced the Cadillac at 80 mph on a 65 mph maximum freeway. The officers also noticed that the driver of the Cadillac was unable to maintain lane position as they traveled eastbound. An enforcement stop was made on the Cadillac. The driver exhibited signs of alcohol intoxication. The officers administered a series of field sobriety tests to the driver, which she was unable to satisfactorily perform. A breath test indicated the presence of alcohol greater than 0.08%, the California legal limit.
