The defendant, Ms Jennifer Tant and her boyfriend Mr. Chris Cagle had gone out on 5-27-08 for drinks. They came home in the early hours of 5-28-08 and began arguing. The altercation turned physical. PD was unable to determine who the primary aggressor was. The defendant stated that she was struck in the head with her own purse by Mr. Cagle. Mr. Cagle stated that the defendant hit him in the head with an umbrella. Both parties were given multiple chances to leave the premises but both refused to leave. The defendant and Mr. Cagle had visible marks, none of which seemed to be defensive in nature. Both parties were intoxicated.

On 05-28-08 at 0440 hours, Officers responded to : _____ in response to a domestic disturbance. The parties involved are currently dating. Both parties were intoxicated. The defendant and the victim were having a verbal argument on the way home from a local bar. Once at the listed location the argument became physical. Both parties struck each other resulting in visible marks. The defendant had a raised area on the right side of his head while the victim had a scrape on her upper left lip and a sore/red left upper arm. The defendant was struck in the head with an umbrella while the victim was struck in the head with a purse. The defendant also stated that he pushed the victim away. Both parties stated they were not going to leave the location. The defendant stated that the location was his house, he was not leaving, and that the victim needed to leave and get out of his life. The victim stated she was not leaving the location and that she was going to jail. Both parties reside at the location. Both parties repeatedly went from being compliant with Officers to being disorderly on numerous occasions. Due to state domestic violence laws both parties were considered to be the primary aggressor in the incident and both parties were taken into custody.
