REQUEST FOR REVOCATION OF PROBATION

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DECLARATION RE REVOCATION OF PROBATION

The undersigned declares that:

The defendant is currently on Superior Court probation.

Subsequent to the defendant's grant of probation, undersigned was informed by way of the attached reports, incorporated herein by reference, that the defendant violated his probation by violating the following conditions of probation:

Failed to obey orders of the Court.

Failed to obey all laws

Failed to obey the rules and regulations of the Probation Department

Do not use or possess any narcotics, dangerous or restricted drugs, or controlled substances without a lawful prescription

Do not use or possess any narcotics paraphernalia

Do not associate with persons known to be narcotic or drug users or sellers, except in an authorized drug counseling program.

Specifically, defendant violated the above conditions of probation by:

(1) Being under the influence of methamphetamine, opiates, and marijuana on May 8, 2007.

(2) Possessing methamphetamine on May 8, 2007.

(3) Possessing drug paraphernalia (i.e. methamphetamine glass pipe) on May 8, 2007.

A new case has been filed in the Kern County Superior Court, Case No. BF119189, alleging felony violations of Health & Safety Code section 11377(a), 11379, 11350(a), and misdemeanor violations of Business & Professions Code section 4060, and Penal Code section 594(b)(2).

The offense was referred to the City Attorney for misdemeanor prosecution because

A new prosecution was declined because the defendant violated the terms and conditions of probation but

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
these violations do not constitute a new criminal offense.

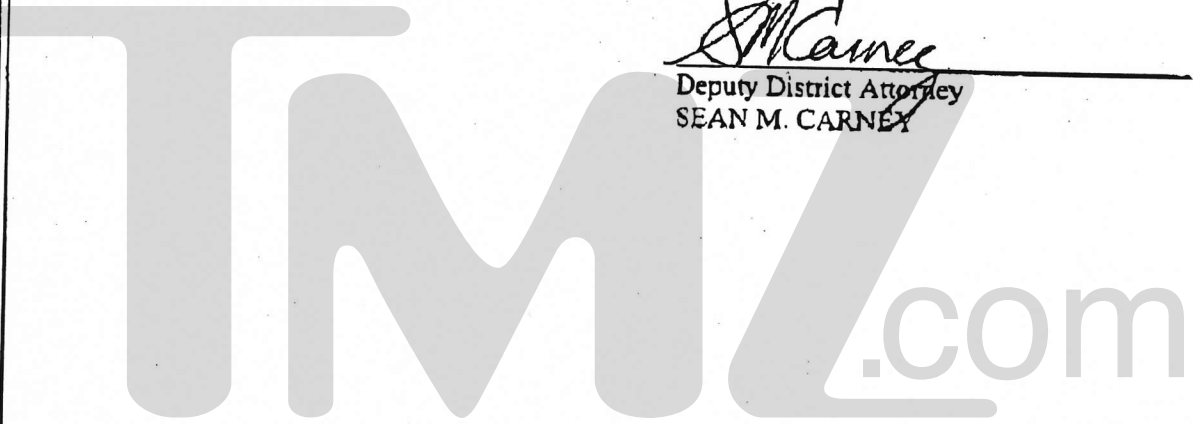
[] The probation revocation request is being filed in lieu of a new prosecution in the interests of judicial economy.
