Comments
 Officers conducted a traffic stop of a car driven by susp. Butler, with susp. Griffin as the passenger. Officers detected a strong odor of MJ coming from within the car, and saw an open vodka bottle on the passenger floorboard. The vehicle was impounded because susp. Butler's CDL was suspended. The car is not registered to either of these two suspects, but, rather, to a 3rd person. An impound search of the car yielded a purple bag that was located in the trunk. Inside the bag was a baggie of MJ (total gross weight of 25.14 gms/.89 ounces), \$1,236 in cash and a cell phone. Neither susp. made any statements. Insufficient evidence to prove beyond a reasonable doubt that either/both suspect(s) had knowledge of, or dominion and control over, the MJ in the trunk of a car that belonged to a 3rd party who was not present. Even if one were to open the trunk, the baggie of MJ would not be visible since it was contained within an opaque container (the purple bag). Reject H&S 11359 on both suspects.
