1 I, Nigel Armstrong, hereby declare that:

2 1. I am not a party to the above-captioned action. I have personal knowledge of the  
3 matters stated herein and if called as a witness and sworn, I could competently testify thereto.

4 2. I am a tennis instructor and tennis player in London and also care for the children  
5 of a prominent family in London, England.

6 3. I met Rob and Sheryl Lowe and their children, Matthew and John Owen (the  
7 "Lowe Family") when the Lowe Family was in London in or about August 2005 through  
8 December 2005. I met the Lowe Family through their friendship with my employer. During the  
9 time the Lowe Family was in London, I provided tennis instruction to Matthew and John Owen.  
10 During one of the early tennis lessons with Matthew and John Owen, I met Jessica Gibson, the  
11 former nanny for the Lowe Family. I saw Jessica often when she was in London with the Lowe  
12 Family.

13 Interactions With Jessica Gibson

14 4. Jessica told me shortly after we first met that she was interested in me. I was  
15 flattered that a twenty-two year old woman would have such an interest in me. I was forty-eight  
16 at the time. I made it clear to Jessica that I was in a serious relationship and I would not break up  
17 with my girlfriend.

18 5. During the following few months that I knew Jessica, she was very forward with  
19 me and did not seem concerned with being discreet. For example, on one occasion, in the  
20 evening when Matthew and John Owen and were running around in my employer's home, I  
21 walked into the kitchenette area. Jessica was standing in the kitchenette and had taken off her  
22 pants and underwear and invited me to have sex even though the boys were in the general area. I  
23 was shocked by her audacity. I told her that we could not do that and walked out of the room.

24 6. On another occasion, during a field trip in which we took Matthew, John Owen  
25 and one of the children I take care of to Hampton Court Palace, she would try to hold my hand  
26 and try to kiss me and make-out whenever the boys were out of sight, even though we were in a  
27 public area.
