FELONY COMPLAINT

The undersigned is informed and believes that:

COUNT 1

On or about June 20, 2008, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of CRIMINAL THREATS, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 422, a Felony, was committed by NATHANIEL DWAYNE HALE, who did willfully and unlawfully threaten to commit a crime which would result in death and great bodily injury to LATOYA C., with the specific intent that the statement be taken as a threat. It is further alleged that the threatened crime, on its face and under the circumstances in which it was made, was so unequivocal, unconditional, immediate and specific as to convey to LATOYA C. a gravity of purpose and an immediate prospect of execution. It is further alleged that the said LATOYA

C. was reasonably in sustained fear of his/her safety and the safety of his/her immediate family.

"NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code section 1192.7(c)."

COUNT 2

On or about June 21, 2008, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of CRIMINAL THREATS, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 422, a Felony, was committed by NATHANIEL DWAYNE HALE, who did willfully and unlawfully threaten to commit a crime which would result in death and great bodily injury to LATOYA C., with the specific intent that the statement be taken as a threat. It is further alleged that the threatened crime, on its face and under the circumstances in which it was made, was so unequivocal, unconditional, immediate and specific as to convey to LATOYA C. a gravity of purpose and an immediate prospect of execution. It is further alleged that the said LATOYA C. was reasonably in sustained fear of his/her safety and the safety of his/her immediate family.

"NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code section 1192.7(c)."

COUNT 3

On or about June 23, 2008, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of STALKING, in violation of PENAL CODE SECTION 646.9(a), a Felony, was committed by NATHANIEL DWAYNE HALE, who did willfully, maliciously, and repeatedly follow, and did willfully and maliciously harass LATOYA C., and made a

credible threat with the intent that she be placed in reasonable fear for her safety and the safety of her immediate family.

COUNT 4

On or about June 23, 2008, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of DRIVING WHEN PRIVILEGE SUSPENDED FOR PRIOR DUI CONVICTION, in violation of VEHICLE CODE SECTION 14601.2(a), a Misdemeanor, was committed by NATHANIEL DWAYNE HALE, who did unlawfully drive a motor vehicle upon a highway at a time when his/her driving privilege was suspended and revoked for driving under the influence of an alcoholic beverage and a drug, and their combined influence, and when he/she had knowledge of said suspension and revocation.

It is further alleged that the defendant suffered the following prior convictions:
