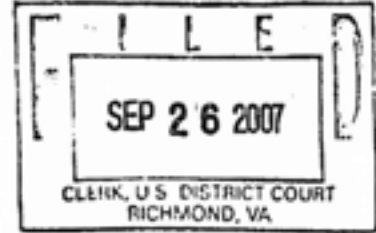

COMES NOW Patricia Locket-Ross, PROBATION OFFICER, presenting an official report upon the conduct of defendant Michael Dwayne Vick, who was placed under pretrial release supervision by the Honorable Dennis W. Dohnal sitting in the Court at Richmond, Virginia, on September 26, 2007, with special conditions to include the following: **refrain from use or unlawful possession of a narcotic drug or other controlled substance defined in 21 U.S.C. 802, unless prescribed by a licensed medical practitioner.**

RESPECTFULLY PRESENTING PETITION FOR ACTION OF COURT AND FOR CAUSE AS FOLLOWS:

The defendant submitted a urine sample on September 13, 2007, which tested positive for marijuana.

PRAYING THAT THE COURT WILL ORDER the defendant's conditions of release be modified to require him to submit to and pay for substance abuse testing and/or treatment and a electronically monitored curfew as directed by Pretrial Services.


ORDER OF COURT

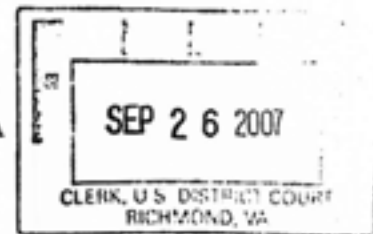

ORDER
(Amending Order Setting Conditions of Pretrial Release)

THIS MATTER is before the Court on a Petition for Action on Conditions of Pretrial Release filed by the U.S. Probation Officer on September 24, 2007. Defendant was placed under pretrial release supervision by Magistrate Judge Dennis W. Dohnal on July 26, 2007.

It is HEREBY ORDERED that the Order Setting Conditions of Pretrial Release for the Defendant is AMENDED to add the following conditions:


7(q): Defendant shall submit to any method of testing required by the pretrial services officer or the supervising officer for determining whether the defendant is using a prohibited substance. Such methods may be used with random frequency and include urine testing, the wearing of a sweat patch, a remote alcohol testing system, and/or any form of prohibited substance screening or testing;

7(r): Defendant shall continue/participate in a program of inpatient or outpatient substance therapy and mental health counseling, if deemed advisable by the pretrial services officer or supervising officer and shall pay the costs of such treatment as required; and

7(t)(i): Defendant is restricted to his residence every day from 10:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., or as directed by the pretrial services officer or supervising officer. This home confinement program will include electronic monitoring and Defendant will pay all or part of the cost of the program based upon his ability to pay as determined by the pretrial services officer or supervising officer.

The Clerk is directed to send a copy of this Order to all counsel of record and the United States Probation Office.

It is SO ORDERED.
