**SWORN ANSWER TO PETITION FOR DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE AND
MOTION TO DISMISS**

FOR HER ANSWER the Wife, VA'SHAUNDYA NELSON O'NEAL, says:

1. The allegation contained in paragraph 1 is **ADMITTED**.
2. The allegation contained in paragraph 2 is **ADMITTED**.
3. The allegations contained in paragraph 3 are **ADMITTED**.
4. The allegation contained in paragraph 4 is **ADMITTED**.
5. The allegation contained in paragraph 5 is **DENIED**.
6. The Wife neither **ADMITS** nor **DENIES** the allegations contained in paragraph 6, but instead moves to **DISMISS** the allegations based on the Husband's failure to attach the Agreement to his Petition as required by Rule 1.130 of Fla. R. Civ. P.
7. The allegations contained in paragraph 7 are **ADMITTED**.

8. The allegations contained in paragraph 8 are **ADMITTED**, with the exception of the word "former" in reference to the marital residence, which reference is specifically **DENIED**.

9. The allegations contained in paragraph 9 are **ADMITTED**.

10. As to the allegations contained in paragraph 10, the Wife is unaware of any litigation or custody proceeding regarding the minor children in which the Petitioner/Husband has participated and therefore she **ADMITS** same.

11. To the Wife's best knowledge, she **ADMITS** the allegations contained in paragraph 11.

12. The allegations contained in paragraph 12 are **ADMITTED**.

13. The allegations contained in paragraph 13 are **ADMITTED**.

14. As to the allegations contained in paragraph 14, the Wife **ADMITS** that the parties acquired personal property during the course of the marriage and that said personal property should be equitably distributed, but specifically **DENIES** the remaining allegations contained in paragraph 14.

15. As to the allegations contained in paragraph 15, the Wife **DENIES** that she has been "secretive" about her assets. Further she is without knowledge as to what is meant by "...in other entities". The Wife **DENIES** the Husband is legally entitled to an accounting. Nonetheless, having nothing to hide with respect to her assets she agrees to provide same. The Wife **DENIES**, objects to, and seeks to strike any suggestions and innuendos emanating from

paragraph 15 that propose that the Wife has done something untoward with assets or monies that might belong to her Husband. She has not. These allegations have generated substantial public comment and rumor that unfairly and negatively reflect upon the Wife's honesty and integrity, and cast aspersions on her character, thus causing her emotional pain and embarrassment without legal or factual basis or justification.

16. As to the allegations contained in paragraph 16, the Wife is **WITHOUT KNOWLEDGE** and therefore **DENIES** same.

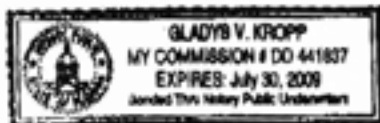
WHEREFORE the Wife prays this Court dismiss the Petition and deny the relief sought.


