**COUNT 1**

"NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code section 1192.7(c)."

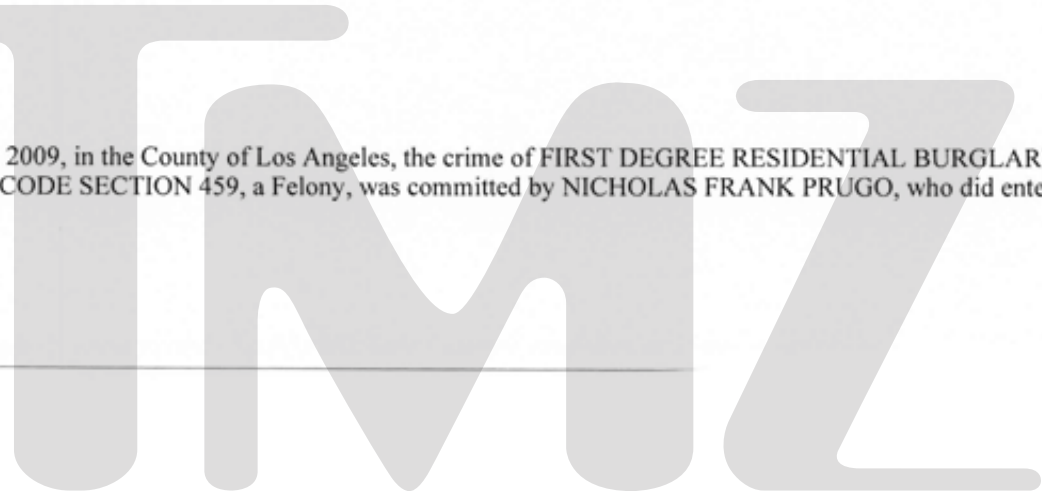
It is further alleged that the above offense is a violation of Penal Code Section 462(a).
