1 MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES

2 **RESPONDENT IS ENTITLED TO "NEED" BASED ATTORNEY'S FEES**

3 A. The Court retains jurisdiction to award attorneys fees in a dissolution  
4 proceeding.

5 Along with all other issues in a domestic relations status action, the Superior  
6 Court has express subject matter jurisdiction to "inquire into and render any judgment  
7 and make orders that are appropriate concerning ... the award of attorney's fees and  
8 costs." *Family Code* §2010(f). Pursuant to *Family Code* sections 2030 and 2032, the  
9 Court is empowered to order the payment of fees and costs as between the parties  
10 based on their relative circumstances (i.e., respective incomes and needs and abilities  
11 to pay) in order to ensure a parity of legal representation in the action. These fees and  
12 costs may be awarded by the judgment and/or at any time during pendency of the  
13 action. *Family Code* §2030; see, *Marriage of Green*, 6 Cal.App.4th 584, 593 (1992).

14 Such awards are supposed to ensure the parties are in positions of relatively  
15 equal litigating strengths in light of their respective incomes and needs and respective  
16 abilities to pay. *Family Code* §2030(a). The established public policy of this state  
17 mandates that trial courts grant adequate and timely interim orders for reasonable  
18 attorneys fees and costs to the financially disadvantaged party. *Marriage of Hatch*, 169  
19 Cal.App.3d 1213, 1218-19 (1985). Access to the family courts through competent  
20 representation is critical. There needs to be a level playing field in order for Respondent  
21 to be able to assert his claims in this case pertaining to the paramount issue of child  
22 custody.

23 It would be an abuse of discretion to force Respondent's attorneys to finance  
24 their client's case by "waiting until trial" for an adequate award of attorneys fees and  
25 costs. As further expressed by the Hatch decision:

26 It is a fact of life that attorneys representing clients in family law cases  
27 frequently do not receive payment in full and adequate compensation for  
28 the services they perform. The approach suggested by the trial court [to

1 wait until the end of trial for an attorney fee order] would make matters  
2 even worse. It would compel the attorney to finance the litigation by  
3 deferring receipt of payment for services until months or years after they  
4 are performed, while the attorney would have to personally advance the  
5 costs of overhead attributable to the case. Even worse, it would require  
6 attorneys to advance from their own pocketbooks sizable expenditures  
7 required as a matter of course in such litigation, such as expenses for  
8 depositions and experts. Banks and finance companies are licensed for  
9 the purpose of lending money; lawyers are not.

10 *Id.* at 1218, n.2.

11 B. Petitioner has the ability to pay Respondent's litigation expenses.

12 *Family Code* section 2032(b) provides, in pertinent part:

13 The fact that the party requesting an award of attorneys' fees and costs  
14 has resources from which the party could pay the party's own attorneys'  
15 fees and costs is not itself a bar to an order that the other party pay part  
16 or all of the fees and costs requested. Financial resources are only one  
17 factor for the court to consider in determining how to apportion the overall  
18 cost of the litigation equitably between the parties under their relative  
19 circumstances.

20 Respondent has no cash flow other than spousal support which will terminate on  
21 November 15, 2007 and child support of \$15,000 per month. Petitioner has a huge  
22 estate and average monthly income of \$737,868 per her Income and Expense  
23 Declaration dated May 21, 2007, which provide indisputable evidence of her ability to  
24 pay attorney's fees and costs without financial hardship.

25 Respondent has an immediate and dire need for attorney's fees. Respondent  
26 suffers the much greater need for contribution to his litigation expenses in order to  
27 maintain effective legal representation and protect his rights. Respondent should not be  
28 required to further impair the capital of his relatively modest separate property estate in

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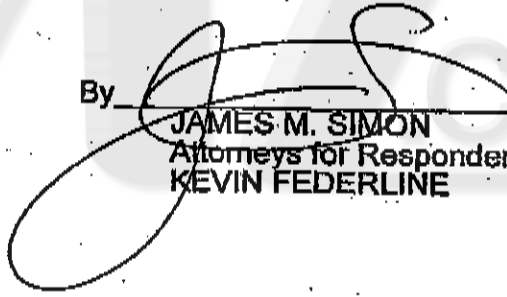
1 order to pay his attorneys on an interim basis. See, *Marriage of Stephenson*, 162.  
2 Cal.App.3d 1057, 1090 (1984).

3 Respondent therefore requests an award for reasonable attorney's fees and  
4 costs in a sum no less than \$100,000. The estimates of Respondent's attorneys  
5 regarding his prospective attorneys fees and costs are reasonable and adequately  
6 supported by the declaration testimony of Mr. Kaplan. See, *Marriage of Keech*, 75  
7 Cal.App.4th 860, 870 (1999).

8 The Courts have recognized that without adequate interim fee awards, the  
9 wealthier party may not act appropriately during litigation and settlement negotiations,  
10 while the disadvantaged party will be discouraged from pursuing legitimate claims and  
11 be forced to accept unfavorable settlement terms. See, *Marriage of Norton*, 206  
12 Cal.App.3d 53, 60-61 (1988).

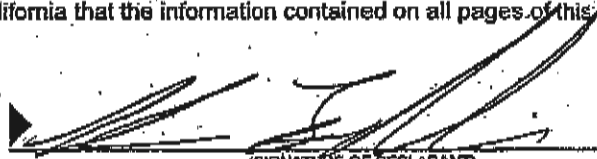

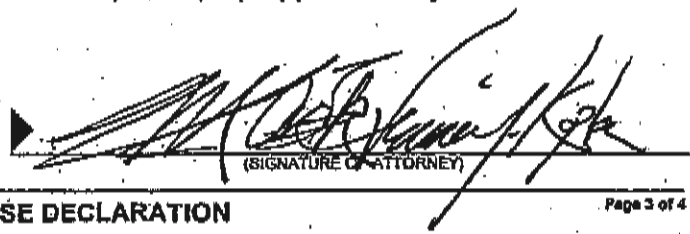
