ADDENDUM

B1. Probable Cause Statement

ON 12-29-2006, APPROXIMATELY 0147 HOURS, I WAS IN THE AREA OF INDIANSCHOOL ROAD AND DRINKWATER BLVD IN SCOTTSDALE PARTICIPATING IN A DUI TASK FORCE. WHILE IN THE AREA I WAS PARKED AT A RED LIGHT BEHIND A BLACK IN COLOR BMW 745I. AS THE LIGHT TURNED GREEN THE VEHICLE ACCELERATED AND IMMEDIATELY BEGAN WEAVING IN THE INSIDE LANE. THE VEHICLE THEN BEGAN WEAVING TO THE OUTSIDE CURB LINE DRIVING ON THE WHITE DIVIDED LINE, SEPARATING THE LANES OF TRAFFIC. THE VEHICLE CONTINUED WEAVING IN THE TWO LANES OF TRAFFIC AS I WAS FOLLOWING THE VEHICLE. THE DRIVER WOULD SPEED UP TO 40 MILES PER HOUR THEN BACK DOWN TO 25 MILES PER HOUR. AS THE VEHICLE APPROACHED THE INTERSECTION OF DRINKWATER AND SCOTTSDALE ROAD THE VEHICLE STOPPED BEHIND A WHITE ACCORD. THE ACCORD WAS STOPPED AT A POSTED STOP SIGN. THE ACCORD TURNED SOUTH ON SCOTTSDALE ROAD AND THE DRIVER OF THE BMW CONTINUED RIGHT AFTER FAILING TO STOP AT THE POSTED STOP SIGN. AS THE BMW PULLED OUT I OBSERVED A BLACK IN COLOR SHERIFF'S OFFICE SPORT UTILITY SLAM ON HIS BREAKS AND MAKE AN EVASIVE MANUEVER TO AVOID A COLLISION WITH THE VEHICLE. I ACTIVATED MY OVERHEAD LIGHTS AND CONDUCTED A TRAFFIC STOP ON THE VEHICLE. THE DRIVER OF THE VEHICLE CONTINUED FOR APPROXIMATELY 100 YARDS AND CONTINUED TO WEAVE IN THE INSIDE LANE. THE DRIVER THEN PULLED OVER TO THE INSIDE CURB LANE AND STOPPED IN THE MIDDLE OF THE LANE. I EXITED MY FULLY OUTFITTED BUCKEYE PATROL VEHICLE AND CONTACTED THE DRIVER OF THE VEHICLE IDENTIFIED AS MIKE TYSON. WHILE SPEAKING WITH MIKE I OBSERVED A WHITE POWDER SUBSTANCE ON THE CENTER CONSOLE OF THE VEHICLE, MIKE WAS WIPING THE DASH OFF AS I APPROACHED. DUE TO MY OBSERVATION I HAD MIKE EXIT HIS VEHICLE TO CONDUCT FIELD SOBRIETY EVALUATIONS. HGN WAS NOT OBSERVED. MIKE PERFORMED POORLY ON THE ONE LEG STAND AND WALK AND TURN. DUE TO SIGNS OF IMPAIRMENT MIKE WAS PLACED IN CUSTODY FOR DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE. SEARCH INCIDENT TO ARREST TWO BAGS OF A WHITE POWDER SUBSTANCE WAS LOCATED IN HIS BACK LEFT POCKET. IN ADDITION A BAG WAS LOCATED ON THE DRIVER SEAT IN A MARLBRO CIGARETTES PACK. MIKE WAS TRANSPORTED TO THE DUI PROCESSING AREA AT CHAPPAREL AND SCOTTSDALE. THERE WAS NO ALCOHOL IN MIKES SYSTEM. I AS A CERTIFIED DRUG RECOGNITION EXPERT CONDUCTED A DRE EVALUATION. A RESULT OF THE EVALUATION INDICATED MIKE WAS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF A DEPRESSANT, STIMULANT AND CANNIBUS. DURING AN INTERVIEW WITH MIKE HE ADMITTED TO USING TODAY AND STATED HE IS AN ADDICT AND HAS A PROBLEM. MIKE ADMITTED TO POSSESSING BAGS OF COCAINE AND SAID HE USES ANY TIME HE CAN GET HIS HANDS ON IT. MIKE WAS TRANSPORTED TO 4TH AVENUE JAIL WHERE HE WAS BOOKED ON THE NARCOTCS AND DRE CHARGES.
